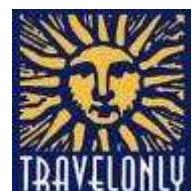

Tuesday, February 17**Depart Toronto**

Destination Israel on EL AL Airlines this evening. Overnight: En route.

Wednesday, February 18**Arrive Israel**

On arrival, clear customs and immigration. We will be met by our local representative, guide and driver. Time permitting enjoy a walk in the ancient city of Jaffa for the sunset over the Mediterranean Sea. **Overnight: Tal Hotel, Tel Aviv x 2 nights.** [D]

Thursday, February 19**Tel Aviv**

Stop at Latrun, headquarters of the Israel Armoured Tank Division and an opportunity to see many of the vehicles that have been used over the past 60 years and video of their successes and failures. Visit Independence Hall, where on May 14, 1948, final documents were signed to create the State of Israel. Drive to Caesarea; see the excavations of the Crusader city and the Roman Port, then visit the new multi media centre in Caesarea. (BD)

Friday, February 20**Galilee**

Depart Tel Aviv north along the Mediterranean coast to Haifa. Drive through the city ascending to the top of Mt Carmel for a breathtaking view of the city below, the expansive coastline and the magnificent Bahai Shrine and Gardens. Continue to Megiddo, one of King Solomon's Chariot cities and site of "Armageddon". This afternoon, sail on the Sea of Galilee and spend time at the Boat Museum at Kibbutz Nof Ginosar where the "Jesus Boat" is on display. **Overnight: Royal Plaza, Tiberias x 3 nights.** [BD]

Saturday, February 21**Galilee**

Visit Capernaum, centre of Jesus' Ministry. Located here are the ruins of an ancient synagogue and the site of Peter's House. Continue to Tabgha and the Mount of Beatitudes. Short drive along the Golan Heights before arriving in Nazareth, where Jesus spent his early years. Walk to the Church of the Annunciation and before departing, visit the recreated ancient Nazareth Village and imagine what life was like during the childhood of Jesus 2000 years ago. Stop at Kibbutz Yifat for an interesting tour and explanation of how this area of the Galilee was cleared to become fertile farming land. Return to Tiberias stopping in Cana and the "wedding church" where Jesus performed the miracle of turning water to wine. Drive along the Golan Heights and see deserted bunkers and the history of its importance over the last 100 years. [BD]

Sunday, February 22**Galilee**

Begin the day with a drive to Baniyas, (Caesarea Philippi) the site of a spring known as Fanium or Pania, after Pan, the Greek god of the shepherds. In ancient times, it was a giant spring, gushing from a cave in the limestone rock, which is the source of the stream Nahal Senir. The Jordan River arises from this spring and two others at the base of Mount Hermon. Here Saint Peter made his confession of Jesus as the Messiah, and Christ in turn gave a charge to Peter. (Matt.xvi.13). Many Greek inscriptions have been found here, some referring to the shrine. Returning to Tiberias, stop at the Yarden Winery and enjoy a tour of the property then sample selections of red, white and dessert wines before rejoining the bus and stopping at Yardenit, the source of the Jordan River. (BD)

Monday, February 23**Galilee / Jerusalem**

Depart the Galilee towards Jerusalem and the Jordan Valley. Stop at Beit Shean, dating back more than 5,000 years, where excavations have revealed 18 levels of history. Ascend to Jerusalem and view the "city of gold" from Mt Scopus before checking in at your hotel. **Overnight: Moriah Classic, Jerusalem x 5 nights.** [BD]

Tuesday, February 24**Jerusalem**

Visit the tomb of King David and Room of the Last Supper on Mt. Zion. Enter the walled city and walk through the restored Jewish Quarter. Visit the Roman Cardo, Herodian Quarter and continue to the Western Wall. Walk along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre; proceed to Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of the Old City, the Kidron Valley, then walk down to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations. Visit the Israel Museum where you will see some of the original Dead Sea Scrolls and a recreation of Jerusalem during the 2nd Temple. [BD]

Wednesday, February 25**Jerusalem**

Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea. Stop at Qumran and learn of its past and also the location where a shepherd boy discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls. Continue to Masada, last stronghold of the Jewish Zealots against the Romans. Cable car to the summit ruins and marvel at the organized town that existed there during this period. An opportunity will be provided to experience weightlessness in the Dead Sea by floating in the mineral rich waters before returning to Jerusalem past numerous Bedouin camps. (BD)

Thursday, February 26**Jerusalem**

The day will be dedicated to an in depth tour of Yad Vashem Memorial, the memorial to the Holocaust and its victims, both Jews and non Jews. Walk through the simple but impacting Children's Memorial, the new museum designed by well known architect, Moshe Safte, designer of Expo '67's "Habitat". Yad Vashem, the Holocaust Martyrs' and Heroes' Remembrance Authority, was established in 1953 by an act of the Israeli Knesset. Since its inception, Yad Vashem has been entrusted with documenting the history of the Jewish people during the Holocaust period, preserving the memory and story of each of the six million victims, and imparting the legacy of the Holocaust for generations to come through its archives, library, school, museums and recognition of the Righteous among the Nations. Located on Har Hazikaron, the Mount of Remembrance, in Jerusalem, Yad Vashem is a vast, sprawling complex of tree-studded walkways leading to museums, exhibits, archives, monuments, sculptures, and memorials. (BD)

Friday, February 27**Jerusalem**

This morning tour the Davidson Centre and learn of the significance of the area it encompasses, including the market place during the time of Jesus in Jerusalem and the steps ascending to the temple mount and site of the 2nd temple. The balance of the day is free to relax or explore the old city on your own. Shabbat dinner at the hotel this evening (BD)

Saturday, February 28**Excursion to Abu Gosh & Bethlehem**

This morning travel to Abu Gosh just outside of Jerusalem it is named after the Abu Gosh family and almost all the villagers are their descendants. Originally, the people were probably Caucasians who came from the mountains of the Caucasus. The villagers are well known for the friendly, close relationship they have with their neighbouring Jewish inhabitants. For many generations the village has provided a stopover for pilgrims and travelers on their way to Jerusalem, and it was at this site they paid a toll fee for their transit. Drive to Bethlehem* tour the Church of the Nativity. Enjoy a farewell dinner before late check out and evening transfer to the airport for your return flight to Toronto. (BD) * circumstances permitting

Sunday, March 1**Israel / Toronto**

Your flight departs Israel after midnight, arriving in Toronto early this morning.

TRAVEL & HEALTH DOCUMENTS

A Canadian citizen must be in possession of a passport that will be valid for a minimum of 6 months from the conclusion of their journey. Tour participants must also ensure that they comply with all visa and health requirements of Israel.

RESERVATIONS & DEPOSIT

Early reservations are recommended as all services are on a request basis, both for air travel and land requirements. A guaranteed minimum deposit of \$500.00 per person is required at time of booking to confirm your request for participation. Full and final payment is required no later than December 1st, 2008.

REFUNDS, CHANGES & CANCELLATIONS

Deposit is non refundable up to December 10th, 2008
